No.G.20012/25/2018-P&E: In the interest of general public the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to fix the quantum of ex-gratia payable to the families of victims and victims of electrical accidents at the following rates as per decision of the Council of Ministers taken in its meeting held on 6.4.2021.

1.1 Category A: Accidents on account of the following:

- a) Snapped Conductor
- b) Snapped Service Wire
- c) Sagged Conductor due to slanting of post and insulator burst.
- d) Breakage of poles
- e) Shock from transformer structure without adequate fencing and transformer burst.
- f) Power leakage through Earth wire, Guy wire, Stay wire.

1.2 The Quantum of Ex-Gratia to be paid in case of loss of human life or injury due to Category 'A' will be as below:-

- (a) In case of loss of human life₹ 10,00,000/-
- (b) In case of disability, ex-gratia payment shall be made depending upon the percentage of disability sustained by the victim at the following rates:
 - 1) Disability upto 20 %

....₹ 2 lakhs

2) Disability upto 21 % - 50 %

....₹ 5 lakhs

3) Disability upto 51 % - 80 %

....₹ 7 lakhs

4) Disability upto 81 % - 100 %

....₹ 10 lakhs

- (c) In case of injury not resulting in disability requiring hospitalization for one or more weeks '₹ 50,000/-
- (d) In case of injury not resulting in disability requiring hospitalization less than one week₹ 10,000/-

2.1 <u>Category B: Accidents on account of the negligence or carelessness of the public as described below:</u>

- a) Accidental Contact with live line while cutting branches of trees and while climbing trees/plucking fruits/climbing on rooftop
- b) While handling iron pipe/ladder/cleaning device
- c) While raising Arch/Loading Vehicles/Fixing banners and posters etc.
- d) While traveling on vehicles
- e) Unauthorized entry in Danger area.
- f) Shock from live conductor on account insufficient clearance due to encroachment

2.2. The Quantum of Ex-Gratia to be paid in case of loss of human life or injury due to Category 'B' will be as below-

(a) In case of loss of human life

....₹ 2,00,000/-

(b) In case of disability, ex-gratia payment shall be made depending upon the percentage of disability sustained by the victim at the following rates:

…₹ 20,000/-
₹ 50,000/-
₹ 70,000/-
₹ 1,00,000/-

- (c) In case of injury not resulting in disability requiring hospitalization for one or more weeks not resulting in disability₹ 10,000/-
- (d) In case of injury not resulting in disability requiring hospitalization less than one week not resulting in disability₹ 5,000/-

3. The ex-gratia payment shall be made payable only on the following conditions:

- (a) The ex-gratia payments in relation to loss of human life shall be made on the basis of post-mortem report with Death Certificate issued by concerned Medical Authorities and the police report.
- (b) The Ex-gratia payments in relation to disability shall be made on the basis of authentic medical documents/certificates issued by the concerned Medical Authorities.
- (c) The ex-gratia payments in relation to hospitalization shall be made on the basis of Medical Certificate issued by concerned Medical Authorities.
- (d) The electrical accidents that occurred from the Power & Electricity Department's installations alone are covered under the scheme. The accidents occurred from consumer installations are not eligible for ex-gratia payment.
- (e) The accidents that occurred due to theft of energy, illegal extraction of electricity for fencing for prevention of theft, fishing, suicide attempt, unauthorized extension of electricity, unauthorized work on live line by general public are not covered by the scheme.
- (f) The claim shall be submitted to the SDO concerned in the prescribed Claim Form appended hereto as Annexure alongwith necessary documents within 3 (three) months from the date of accident. The SDO shall forward such claims received by him to the E-in-C, Power & Electricity Department with a copy to the concerned EE, SE, CE within a period of 1(one) month from the date of receipt of claim for payment of ex-gratia along with the following documents.

- i. Medical Certificate as per claim;
- ii. Police report as per claim;
- iii. Certificate to prove that the claimant is legal heir to the deceased in case of death;
- iv. Proof of guardianship (Adhaar card or Birth Certificate or Voter's ID alongwith 'Hriatpuina' of LC/VC/YMA/YLA/MTP/YCA) in case of minor;
- v. Consent deed in adequate stamp paper notarized by the notary public that he/she shall not approach legal court for enhanced compensation;
- vi. Electrical accident report in the prescribed format (Form 44-A);
- vii. Category of accident certified by electrical inspectorate;
- (g) In case of loss of life, ex-gratia payment will be made to the legal heir. In cases of ex-gratia payments to Minors, ex-gratia payments will be made to the guardian.
- (h) All claims shall be settled within 6 months as far as possible after receipt of all documents in full.
- (i) The Category of accident shall be as per spot verification report carried out by electrical inspectorate.
- (j) The scheme shall not cover any Government employee who is eligible for compensation under Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923.
- (k) This order shall come into force with immediate effect and until further orders.
- (l) This is issued with the vetting of Law & Judicial Department vide I.D No.LJD.33/2020/133 dt.2.11.2020 and with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide I.D No. FIN(E) 330/2020 dt.1.12.2020 and I.D No. FIN(E) 449/2020 dt.11.2.2021
